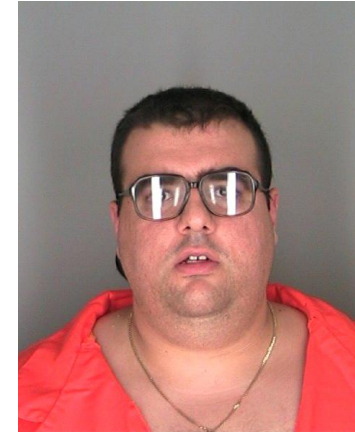

Narrative	<p>Defendant lived with his parents at the above address. Mother was out of town. During a domestic incident Matthew shot and killed his father. Trumansburg Police, Tompkins County Sheriff's deputies, NYS State Police and NYS Park Police responded to 104 Tamarack Lane in the Village of Trumansburg early this morning for a reported shooting. Upon arrival officers found the victim suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to the chest and torso. The victim, identified as Salvatore P. Taranto age 58 of 104 Tamarack Lane was transported to Cayuga Medical Center by Trumansburg Ambulance. The victim died shortly thereafter.</p> <p>Police arrested Matthew Taranto, age 28, and charged him with second-degree murder in connection with the incident. Matthew Taranto was arraigned in Ulysses Town Court where he was remanded to the Tompkins County Jail with no bail set. Matthew Taranto is scheduled to reappear in Ulysses Town Court on Monday December 6th 2010 at 2:00pm. The investigation is ongoing with the assistance of the New York State Police and the Tompkins County Sheriff's Office.</p> <p>Photo of Matthew Taranto below.</p> <p>On December 6th when Taranto was brought to Town of Ulysses Court the defense waived the felony hearing. Taranto was sent back to Tompkins County Jail with no bail. Taranto case is awaiting grand jury action.</p>

Narrative	<p>Trumansburg Police have charged Eugene A Dailey age 38 with burglary 2nd a class C violent felony along with other charges regarding a break- in to a village home back on August 27th, 2011. In the early morning hours of August 27th Dailey is accused of breaking into the home which was occupied by the owner and her two house guests who all were sleeping at the time. Entry was made by by forcing an inner garage door. The victim was woken up and found an intoxicated Dailey drinking her beer inside the home. After a period of time she got him to leave.</p> <p>Investigation of the owner's complaint was that she had been dating Dailey but broke up with Dailey after mental and physical abuse. Dailey was a salesman and victim knew he had been in trouble with the legal system.</p> <p>Police obtained an arrest warrant for Dailey who was living and working in the Canandaigua area. Area police were notified as well as NYS parole. Dailey has a history of violent crime convictions with a knife.</p> <p>During the course of the next few weeks Dailey eluded police but made many harassing calls back to the victim pleading and threatening her with harm. Police watched the home and had her leave for several days.</p> <p>Trumansburg investigators notified State parole officers that Dailey was sent a paycheck for a partial week by a former employer to an address Dailey had given him in Wayne County. Parole watched the building and Dailey showed and was taken into custody and remanded to Wayne County Jail.</p> <p>State parole had revocation hearings based on the Trumansburg charges and Dailey's parole was revoked and will stay in state prison for two more years. His</p>



case is now being reviewed by the DA's office for local charges.
